

ORDINANCE NO. 116

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS, OR HIS DULY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO SELL OR EXCHANGE ANY MUNICIPAL SUPPLIES, MATERIALS OR EQUIPMENT BELOW A SPECIFIED SUM WITHOUT NECESSITY OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING: ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM LIMIT: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Barling, Arkansas, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the City of Barling, Arkansas, or his duly authorized representative, may sell or exchange any municipal supplies, materials or equipment without competitive bidding for all items or lots of supplies, material, or equipment with a value less than the maximum amount of \$ 10000.

SECTION 2: That each item or lot to be disposed of as one unit of supplies, material or equipment exceeding in value the amount of \$ 10000 shall be sold by competitive bidding, unless the Mayor shall certify in writing to the City Council that in his opinion the fair market value of such item or lot is less than the amount established by this ordinance.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

SECTION 4: The City of Barling, Arkansas, presently is in possession of several items of municipal supplies, materials and equipment of which it is no longer in need, and the storage and protection of these items has become a burden to the City so that an emergency is therefore declared and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
