

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTROLLING
AND REGULATING DOMESTICATED ANIMALS IN THE
CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Barling,
Arkansas that:

SECTION 1: It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person owning, possessing or having control of any fowl including but not limited to chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys and guineas and other domesticated animals such as horses, cattle, swine, mules, goats, asses or other animals of like kind to be permitted to run at large or to be pastured or staked out within the city limits of Barling, however, said animals may be kept within the City provided they are restrained and within a securely fenced enclosure.

SECTION II: Any other person owning, keeping or controlling any animals including cats and dogs shall be solely responsible for seeing that said animals refrain from making a nuisance in any manner to the extent of violating the peaceful and quiet enjoyment of other persons within the City of Barling, Arkansas.

SECTION III: Irrespective of the foregoing sections should any person who owns, possesses or otherwise controls any of the aforesaid animals cause, create or thereby permit any obnoxious odors or noise to the extent that the same impairs the safety, health or reasonable enjoyment of other residents of the City, said person shall be considered to be in violation of this ordinance.

SECTION IV: Any person or persons found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor and fined up to \$100.00 per offense.

SECTION V: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this ordinance shall not effect the validity of the other parts of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

SECTION VI: The inactment of this ordinance would insure the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public in the City of Barling, Arkansas so that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
