

ORDINANCE NO. 150

An Ordinance Prohibiting the Obstruction of
Traffic Views

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of
Barling, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to allow
trees, shrubbery, fences, parked automobiles or any other growth or
property of any kind to obstruct the ability of the operator of a
moving vehicle to view lanes of traffic such that the operator cannot
proceed with reasonable safety.

SECTION 2: The penalty for the violation of this ordinance
shall be a fine in the amount of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).

SECTION 3: The enactment of this ordinance would insure the
protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public in the City
of Barling, Arkansas, so that an emergency is hereby declared to exist
and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage.
