## ORDINANCE NO. 161

An Ordinance Permitting Close Site Drilling Within the City Limits of Barling, Arkansas Upon the Approval of Property Owners and the Issuance of a Permit

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Barling, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1: It shall be permissible to conduct close site drilling for oil, gas and other minerals within the City of Barling, Arkansas, upon the approval in writing of eighty percent (80%) of all owners of real property within 500 feet of the drill site. The approval shall be obtained by having the property owner sign the following authorization:

The undersigned real property owner hereby consents to drilling operations to be performed by [insert name] within 500 feet of property owned by me.

## Property Owner

SECTION 2: The approval of the property owners in accordance with Section 1 shall be presented to the City Administrator of Barling within ten (10) days of proposed drilling operations at which time the City Administrator shall issue a permit allowing the drilling operations. Said permit shall be effective for one (1) year or until such time as drilling operations or production have ceased whichever period is later.

SECTION 3: Any person, firm or corporation in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined up to the sum of One Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) and each day of violation of this Ordinance shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 4: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and, specifically, Ordinance No. 130 is hereby repealed. This Ordinance is not intended to amend, modify or repeal existing ordinances pertaining to public nuisances, noise restrictions, or other ordinances of a general and permanent nature.
