ORDINANCE NO. 200

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Barling, Arkansas:

 $\frac{\text{SECTION 1:}}{\text{hose while}} \text{ It shall be prohibited for any person to drive any vehicle over a fire hose while} \text{ the same is being utilized in an emergency situation without the express consent of the Fire Chief or a member of the City of Barling Volunteer Fire Department.}$

SECTION 2: It shall be prohibited for any person to park any vehicle in front of the entrance to any fire station so as to obstruct the movement of emergency vehicles.

SECTION 3: It shall be prohibited for any person to pursue an emergency vehicle while said emergency vehicle is responding to an emergency situation.

SECTION 4: It shall be prohibited for any vehicle to park within one hundred (100) feet of a fire or other emergency situation to which the Barling Volunteer Fire Department has responded.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 5:}}$ Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined a sum of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00).

SECTION 6: The provisions of any Ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Those provisions of Ordinance 11 in conflict with the provisions contained herein are specifically repealed.

SECTION 7: The Board of Directors finds that the interference with the operation of the Barling Volunteer Fire Department in an emergency situation would be hazardous to the lives and property of the residents of the City of Barling and therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
