

ORDINANCE NO. 215

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 190  
TO PROVIDE WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY  
OF THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Phase I restrictions of Section 1 of Ordinance  
No. 190 are hereby amended to read in full as follows:

- (1) The following uses of water are permitted at locations  
with even-numbered addresses on even-numbered days of the  
month only and at locations with odd-numbered addresses  
on odd-numbered days of the month only:


Lawn watering; watering of shrubs; plants; trees and  
gardens; the washing of motor vehicles, trailers,  
airplanes or boats (not applicable to commercial car  
washes); filling swimming pools or fountains, and  
washing of building exteriors.

- (2) No person shall use water as provided for in this Section  
to such an extent as to allow water to escape from his  
premises onto public property, such as alleys or streets,  
nor onto another person's property.


SECTION 2: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 190 is hereby  
specifically repealed. All other parts and provisions of Ordinance  
No. 179 (not already repealed) and Ordinance No. 190 shall remain  
in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: The enactment of this Ordinance would ensure the  
protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public in the  
City of Barling, Arkansas, in that the conservation of water is  
necessary to maintain an adequate supply for consumption and use,  
the same being in the immediate interest of promoting health,  
safety and general welfare, so that an emergency is hereby declared  
to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from  
and after its passage.
