

**ORDINANCE NO. 244-99-01**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT VARIOUS STANDARD CODE  
IN THE CITY OF BURLING, ARKANSAS**

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City of Barling to adopt, in all respects the various standard Codes relating to amusement devises, building, fire prevention, gas, housing, mechanical, plumbing and swimming pools; and

**WHEREAS**, the adoption of these Codes is done to facilitate property inspection activities by the City of Barling, Sebastian County, Arkansas, relating to construction and to maintenance of buildings within said City of Barling, Sebastian County, Arkansas, and relating to public safety, health and general welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY** the Board of Directors as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The following codes are hereby adopted by reference as if set out word for word herein:

Standard Amusement Devise Code-1995 Edition  
Standard Building Code-1991 Edition  
Standard Existing Building Code-1988 Edition  
Standard Fire Prevention Code-1991 Edition  
Standard Gas Code-1991 Edition  
Standard Housing Code- 1991 Edition  
Arkansas Mechanical Code-1997 Edition  
Standard Plumbing Code- 1991 Edition  
Standard Swimming Pool Code-1991 Edition  
Standard Unsafe Building Abatement Code-1985 Edition

**SECTION 2:** Any matters in said Codes which are contrary to existing Ordinances of the City of Barling, Sebastian County, Arkansas, shall prevail.


**SECTION 3:** When reference is made to the duties of a certain official named in said codes, that designated official of the City of Barling, Sebastian County, Arkansas, who has duties corresponding to those of the named official in said Code shall be deemed to be the responsible official insofar as enforcing the provisions of said Code are concerned


