

ORDINANCE NO. 279

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 129 REGARDING THE SIZE, WEIGHT AND CONSTRUCTION OF GARBAGE CANS IN THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the safety of employees of the city is of primary concern, and

WHEREAS, a major factor in the safe collection of garbage is the size and construction of garbage cans,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS

SECTION 1. Ordinance 129, Section 1, shall be amended regarding the definition of "garbage can" as follow:

"Garbage Can" - A water-tight, galvanized, metal or heavy duty plastic container of the capacitor not less than twenty (20) gallons and not exceeding thirty-two (32) gallons, having a maximum loaded weight of 50 lbs., having two handles on the sides thereof by which it may be lifted, having a tight fitting top with at least one handle, and being so constructed as to permit the free discharge of its contents.

SECTION 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.


SECTION 3. Severability. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and a decision by any court of competent jurisdiction that a provision of this ordinance or any application thereof is illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, shall not affect the legality, validity or constitutionality of the remaining provisions or applications of this ordinance.
