

ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE SALE AND USE
OF FIREWORKS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

OK

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or use within the limits of the City of Barling, Arkansas, any pyrotechnics, commonly known as "fireworks".

SECTION 2. Any person or other legal entity violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$25.00 per violation.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Because the sale and use of pyrotechnics within the City limits of the City of Barling, Arkansas constitutes a danger to the health and safety of the citizens of that City, an emergency is therefore declared and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
