ORDINANCE NO. 93

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: From and after passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any mobile home to be occupied for dwelling or sleeping purposes within the city limits of the City of Barling, as the same now exists or may be hereafter designated, except within the boundaries of a mobile home park duly licensed as such by the City Council, or except within a mobile home subdivision duly approved by the City Council.

SECTION 2: Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ten (\$10.00) dollars nor more than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, and each day of continuing violation of this ordinance shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 3: This ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public health, peace and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
