ORDINANCE NO. 96

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: From and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to move into the city limits of the City of Barling, from outside said city limits, or to move from one location within the city limits of the City of Barling to another location within said city limits, any house, office building or other structure for the purpose of permanently locating such house, office building or other structure within said city limits, unless such person, firm or corporation has obtained a permit as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2: Any person, firm or corporation desiring to move into the city limits of the City of Barling, from outside said city limits, or to move from one location inside said city limits to another location inside said city limits, any house, office building or other structure for the purpose of permanently locating such house, office building or other structure within said city limits, shall make written application to the City Council for a permit, which application shall be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 and a plat showing the site upon which said house, office building or other structure is to be permanently located. Said application must contain information concerning planned repairs or renovation, the intended use on the permanent location, and such other material information as said City Council may request. Before said permit shall be issued, the applicant shall submit satisfactory evidence of compliance with all state plumbing and electrical codes and must certify that all repairs and renovations shall be completed prior to occupancy of the house, office building or other structure. Such house, office building or other structure shall be subject to inspection by any persons designated by the City Council. If said permit shall be granted, it shall be effective for a period of six

a period

months from the date of issuance and, for good cause shown, can be extended for an additional period of six months.

SECTION 3: Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars nor more than two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars. In addition to the penalties provided herein, the City of Barling shall be entitled to any equitable relief for the purpose of preventing a violation of this ordinance and for the purpose of terminating a continuing violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection, health, peace and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
